The Guessing Game

- Work in pairs or small groups. Each group will look through Units 1 through 8 and choose a target word. Together, the group should write 5 clues to describe their target word. EX: If the target word is "pencil," the clues could be "It is long.", "You use it in school.", etc.
- Choose one pair or group to go first. The pair/group reads the first clue.

 The rest of the class tries to guess the word. Allow only one guess after each clue. If the guess is wrong, the pair/group reads the next clue.
- If the class guesses correctly ("Pencil!") on or before the fifth clue, the class wins. If the class cannot guess the right word, the pair/group wins.
 - Continue the activity with a new pair/group.
